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rulers of literary playgrounds politics of intergenerational play in children s literature offers multifaceted reflection on interdependences between children and adults as they engage in play in literary texts and in real life this volume brings together international children s literature scholars who each look at children s texts as key vehicles of intergenerational play reflecting ideologies of childhood and as objects with which children and adults interact physically emotionally and cognitively each chapter applies a distinct theoretical approach to selected children s texts including individual and social play constructive play or play deprivation this collection of essays constitutes a timely voice in the current discussion about the importance of children s play and adults contribution to it vis à vis the increasing limitations of opportunities for children s playful time in contemporary societies

lewis carroll s alice s adventures in wonderland 1865 and through the looking glass 1871

and carlo collodi's *Le avventure di pinocchio* 1883 are among the most influential classics of children's literature firmly rooted in their respective british and italian national cultures the *alice* and *pinocchio* stories connected to a worldwide audience almost like folktales and fairy tales and have become fixtures of postmodernism although they come from radically different political and social backgrounds the texts share surprising similarities this comparative reading explores their imagery and history and discusses them in the broader context of british and italian children's stories

alessandra campana explores how operas and their stage manuals participated in the making of a modern public in late nineteenth century italy

all too often attention is paid only to those children's novels that were written in english with non english language works being passed over and neglected beyond *babar* the european tradition in children's literature examines eleven of the most celebrated european children's novels in substantial critical essays written by well known international scholars this approach provides a comprehensive discussion of the selected works from a variety of theoretical perspectives each essay offers a critical introduction to the text that can serve as a point of departure for literary scholars professors of children's literature primary and secondary school teachers and librarians who are interested in texts that cross languages and cultures beyond *babar* is especially meant to assist instructors of children's literature who would like to use these texts in the classroom in order to begin to redress the english language dominance of many children's literature courses this volume will also be of interest to the general public as its ultimate aim is to bring to the attention of all english speaking readers the literature from other parts of the world in this case from europe beyond *babar* helps to facilitate the border crossings of these european masterpieces of children's literature into the english speaking world

beyond pinocchio is a meticulous examination of renowned author carlo collodi's primers and his debunking italian bourgeois propaganda from within in his government approved books for primary school collodi offered a view of society that was dissonant with the one promoted by italian middle class propaganda in its very core values the family the state and the cultural homogenization collodi's reputation as a supporter of bourgeois values has remained crystallized for decades and even his most famous character *pinocchio* has been seen as embodying those values for many years recently however this reputation has been questioned thereby reframing the wooden puppet within an anti establishment context with this book andrea pagani proves how even collodi's primers deserve a careful re reading throwing light on an author too quickly labelled as an uncritical son of his times at a time when a newborn state was aiming towards a standardized national community collodi wrote of a multicultural italy where the family is an empty concept and linguistic diversity is an asset rather than a hindrance

in 1881 carlo collodi intended simply to write a children's story about an inexplicably animate piece of wood the adventures of *pinocchio* has since become one of italy's most successful literary exports giving life to numerous adaptations the novel is meaningful to college students today as it deals with the difficulty of abandoning childhood the value of education and what it means to be human this volume like others in the mla's approaches to teaching world literature series is divided into two parts part 1 materials gives the

instructor bibliographic information on the text and contexts of the book the critical literature and audiovisual and electronic resources part 2 approaches contains nineteen essays on teaching pinocchio and its adaptations which cover such topics as collodi s life society in post unification italy the gothic element the frankenstein theme myths and archetypes the influence of ariosto and other writers children s literature and censorship the animal fable and how the famous disney movie is both a help and a hindrance in the classroom
